- Course of the Research work (M.Phil/Ph.D)
- Contact Details i.e. Mobile/Landline Numbers/ E-mail Address.

Spacing: 1.5

Margins:

Left: 1.5 inches/ 3.81 cm

Right: 1.0 inches/ 2.54 cm
